

**Global HSE 2017- Hyderabad**  
**The 5th International Conference & Exhibition on Health, Safety & Environment**

The 5th edition of Global HSE Conference and Exhibition on Health, Safety & Environment, hosted by Oil India Limited (OIL), under the Chairmanship of Sri Utpal Bora, the CMD of OIL, is being held at the Hyderabad International Convention Centre (HICC), on 21st - 22nd September, 2017. The theme of the Conference is "HSE Excellence: A Foundation for Sustainable Growth".

The two day Conference cum Exhibition was inaugurated today by Sri K.T. Rama Rao, Hon'ble Cabinet Minister, Ministry of Industries, IT & Commerce, Govt. of Telangana, Sri Naini Narshima Reddy, Hon'ble Minister, Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of Telangana, Sri Jithender Reddy, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Govt. of India, H.E. The Conference is to witness various high level keynote speeches from eminent national and international speakers, Executive Plenary Panels, many Panel Discussions, etc. The major topics in focus during the conference would be related to Process Safety Management, Human Factors in HSE, Contractor Safety Management, Disaster Management, Competency Assurance, Fire Safety Management, HSE best practices, Environmental Management, Enterprise Risk Management, Occupational Health & Wellness, Road Safety, etc.
