However, Indian bidders will not be issued Recommendatory Letter.</p> <p>In the event of an order on indigenous bidder under deemed export scheme, OIL will issue Project Authority Certificate(PAC) and arrange for DGH Certificate as may be appropriate/applicable. Supplier shall effect dispatch only on receipt of these certificates from OIL, failing which all related liabilities shall be to Supplier's account."</p>	<p>The items covered by this enquiry shall be used by Oil India Limited in the PEL/ML areas which are issued/renewed after 01/04/99 and hence Nil Customs Duty during import will be applicable. Indigenous bidder shall be eligible for concessional rate of IGST against Essentiality Certificate for order valuing 10 lakh and above.</p> <p>In the event of an order on indigenous bidder, OIL will issue Project Authority Certificate (PAC), where import content is declared by the bidder for availing Custom Duty benefit on the import content.</p> <p>Supplier shall arrange to provide all necessary documents to apply for the essentiality certificate on receipt of request from OIL, if any. Further, supplier affect dispatch only on receipt of relevant certificates from OIL, failing which all related liabilities shall be to Supplier's account.</p>
