### **CORRIGENDUM – 1 FOR OIL’S TENDER NO. CGI1629P23 DATED: 23-09-2022**

In response to the Tender No. CGI1629P23 DATED: 23-09-2022 published by OIL for *HIRING OF CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT (PMC) FOR 5 NOS.
